## Dear Parents / Guardians:

As we prepare for the start of the 2022-2023 school year, below is some information to be aware of:

Free and reduced lunch forms are available online at the Lincoln County School District #2 website. If your child qualifies for free and reduced lunch, lunch would be billed at that price. For students who do not qualify for free and reduced lunch, meal prices would be as listed below:

Elementary Breakfast \$2.00

Elementary Lunch-\$3.00

There is still a slim possibility that a government agency will pick up the cost for lunches as has occurred over the last two years, but currently it doesn't look promising. If a government agency is able to pay for all meals, this information will be shared out.

This year students will be able to begin arriving for school at 7:40 a.m. This will ensure we have appropriate supervision for your student when they arrive at school. Buses will arrive at 7:40 a.m. and breakfast will begin being served at 7:40 a.m. As normal, the start of the day bell will ring at 8:00 a.m. to begin classes.

We will continue utilizing Raptor this year as a safety precaution. You will remember this means that if you or a guest need to go past the office during regular school hours when students are in the building, you and/or your guest would need to bring a driver's license to scan. Thank you for your cooperation in making our school safer.

As with years past, our Cokeville Elementary handbook is located on the school website. This includes processes and expectations for the year. Please refer to the website for a copy of our handbook and to review the dress code which is included in the handbook.
