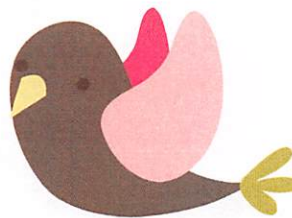
Thank you for your continued support in helping us finish the school year strong. We appreciate your partnership in supporting both the academic growth and well-being of our students.
